**AID-IN-CONSTRUCTION FOR  
THREE-PHASE DISTRIBUTION EXTENSION**

**POLICY 304**

---

**OBJECTIVE**

- A. To enable three-phase line extension to be made to the property line of a single commercial and industrial customers without undo financial risk to Henry County REMC and its members by establishing a criteria for financial aid-in-construction.
- B. To establish a fair and equitable application of aid-in-construction.
- C. To establish criteria for the calculation of aid-in-construction.

**POLICY**

- A. Overhead construction on county right-of-way for the sole benefit of a requesting member:
  - 1. The cost to construct overhead distribution will be calculated.
  - 2. The cost will be collected from the potential member/developer/contractor before construction or ordering of material.
  - 3. During the first 10 years after construction of the primary extension:
    - a. If the extension becomes an integral part of the Henry County REMC distribution system, the aid-in-construction amount will be reimbursed.
    - b. If the extension becomes used by another 3-phase consumer(s) during the first 10 years after construction of the primary extension, Henry County REMC will reimburse the aid-in-construction on a pro-rated basis.

4. The completed construction will remain the property of Henry County REMC.
- B. Primary underground construction, or overhead construction on requesting consumer's property for the sole benefit of a requesting member:
1. Total cost of primary plant, whether overhead or underground, will be calculated and divided over a period of five years (60 months) establishing a minimum monthly bill.
- C. Secondary Construction:
1. It will be the responsibility of the member/contractor/developer to provide and install all secondary service from transformer to disconnect. Henry County REMC will terminate all secondary connections at the transformer.

## **RESPONSIBILITY**

- A. The Line Superintendent and Operations Manager administer and enforce the policy with the assistance of the General Manager.
