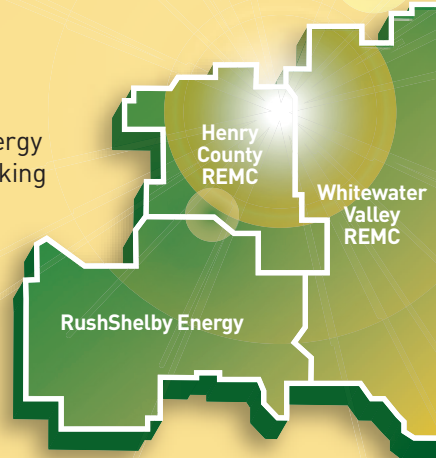


TAPPING INTO POWER OF THE SUN
